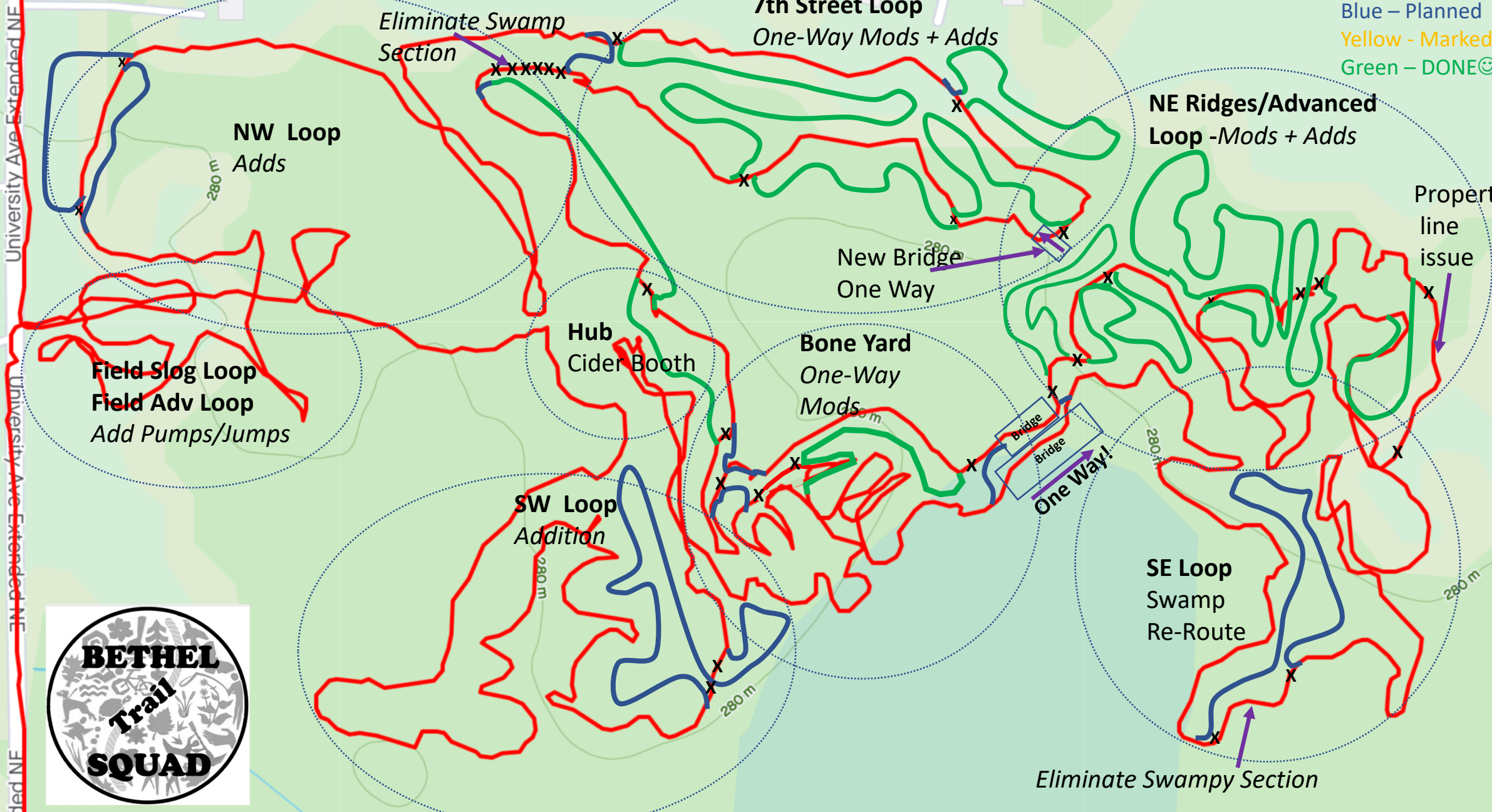


Haunted Forest – AUDACIOUS Trail GOALS

Trail Expansion/Changes

X Fix NE Property Line

X Fix Low Spots by existing Bridge

- Add North Bridge
- Make Unidirectional

X NE Ridges Section expansion

- 7th St Section expansion
- SW section expansion
- NW section expansion
- Eliminate low spots
- New Arrows, Signs, Maps
- New description and map – City Website, Facebook, Trail Forks

Trail Features

- 7th street loop “**Super MEGA Skinny**”
- Add Dirt behind Tractor-Beam and Ponti-Ramp
- Replace Green Plywood ramps on Swing Bridge and Plexi-Ramp

X PHAT Skinny in North West Section

X Add Jumps/Ramps in new NW Section

- Add Pumps and Jumps in Field Slog
- Add Berms after Tractor beam and Ponti ramp
- Add Ramps for 3-4 Log crossings

Parting Lot/Access

- Change “City” Signage

x Clean up Parking Lot

- Burn Wood Pile
- Parking Lot Lights
- Sponsor Signs

Events and Marketing

- Hold a Race - Money for a shipping container
- Bikes Demo Days - Trailhead, Intense, Other?

- New South Access Route for BWMA

- Ease Bethel – Finalize written agreement
- Communicate final park name, get road signs installed
- Parking lot surface improvements
- Write grant request for trail expansion. parking lot paving, trail equipment, Bonde Park access right-away

Short Loop - Flat & twisted introduction ~1.5mi
Medium Loop - Hills and twisted! ~3.5mi
Advanced - Punchy hills, twists, logs and drops
The FULL Scare – Just stay Right! ~6mi
